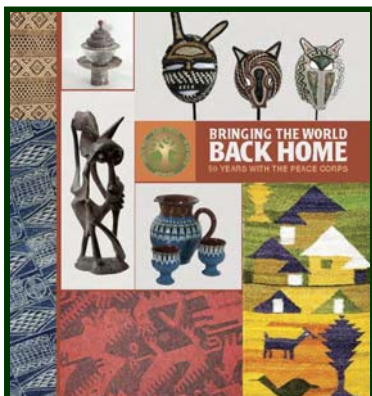

Meeting Minutes

January 19, 2011 the Red Gym

Present

Tom Brodd, Mark Holden, Bekah Johnson, Kim Johnson, Meghan Meeker, Helene Pesche, Lee Row, and Ana Zambie

We observed a moment of silence in memory of Sargent Shriver, who served as the first Peace Corps director who passed away on January 18.

Lee circulated a list of Peace Corps Partnership projects, inviting group members to designate \$1,000 toward the project(s) of their choice.

Officer / Committee Reports

Treasurer

Lee is working with an accountant to prepare our group's 2010 tax returns. Lee proposed that we purchase QuickBooks to facilitate the accounting and tax preparation processes. She volunteers to enter the necessary transactions into the software. Tom motioned to buy QuickBooks using group funds, Helene seconded, and all approved.

Membership

Lee reported that, after mailing 200+ letters to unpaid members, we have received \$775 in payments. She transferred the attendant membership renewal forms to Bekah, our new membership coordinator. Bekah asked the group if she should delete from the membership roster about 15 unpaid members for whom we no longer have valid addresses. We discussed hiding, not deleting, these people from the membership roster, but we decided that Bekah should adopt whichever strategy she finds most effective. Tom suggested that Bekah bring a list of the unpaid members with invalid addresses to the next meeting, so that we can look for individuals whose whereabouts we might know. In conclusion, we expressed our appreciation to Heather, the outgoing membership coordinator, for mentoring Bekah over the past months.

Calendar

Tom announced that the 2011 calendar sales are stronger than last year, although he does not yet have the exact figures to share. Tom estimates that less funds will be available for this year's Special Projects grants (Gift Away) and Peace Corps Partnership project donations, because the Calendar Committee is reserving the entire production amount for the 2012 calendar. The committee is in the process of selecting the cover photo for the 2012 calendar. The 2013 calendar photo voting party will occur on Sunday, January 30 from 1:00 - 4:00 PM in the Memorial Union. The committee is seeking a new chair to replace Tom, when he leaves later this year for VSO service. Tom suggests that we document the history of the calendar production and the individuals who have contributed over the years.

Posters

Helene reported that the Poster Committee is working on the third set of posters. She passed around several mock-ups for the "We All Need Peace" poster and asked that we voted on the most attractive design. She asked if it would be appropriate for the Poster Committee to display and/or sell posters at the Bringing the World Back Home art showcase on March 24. Ana volunteered to take this question to the 50th Anniversary Committee.

Peace Corps 50th Anniversary Committee

Ana reported, on behalf of Kate Schachter who could not attend

the meeting, that the 50th Anniversary Committee is planning a variety of anniversary events:

- (1) International Festival at the Overture Center on March 5,
 - (2) Bringing the World Back Home art showcase at Promega on March 24,
 - (3) UW African Studies / Peace Corps conference on March 24-26, and
 - (4) NPCA Around the World Expo at the Monona Terrace on March 27.
- Ana also shared an email from Kate about the "Peace Train," an Amtrak trip that is being organized to Washington, D.C. for the 50th Anniversary events in September.

Old Business

Memorial Donation

In 2009, the UW Alumni Club of Austin, Texas sent our group a \$450 unrestricted donation in memory of Jeff Rothmeier, who loved both the University of Wisconsin and Peace Corps. Tom motioned to donate these funds to the 50th Anniversary Committee in support of the art exhibit. Lee will post this motion in the newsletter, so that we can vote on it in the next meeting.

New Business

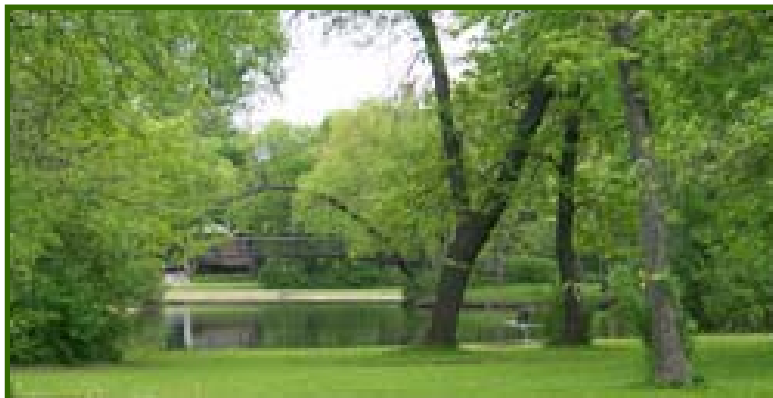
Tenney Park Shelter Tile

50th Anniversary Events

The 50th Anniversary Committee is working to identify projects and activities to be spread out over 2011 to celebrate 50 years of Peace Corps.

January 22, 2011 - Freeze for Food

This was our 30th annual Freeze for Food. That's a lot of freezing! We began our year of celebration by expanding this event to participants worldwide. As in recent years, all proceeds go to the Colombia Support Network whose members also helped with the event. CSN will make sure the money gets to the Peace Community of San Jose de Apartado. Group members enjoyed a potluck after the big freeze at Rick and Masako Lackey's home nearby.

Expenses were high this year because we need lots of insurance (\$400!), but many turned out to race and to help in the truly freezing temperatures. Peter Joyce counted 205 participants and 24 volunteers and \$2,659 was raised for San Jose.

March 5, 2011 - Global House Party

The annual Overture Center International Festival showcases Dane County artists, performers, and vendors with international connections. This year we will sell our calendars and posters as usual, but since this year is Peace Corps' 50th birthday, the Overture Center offered us space to do whatever we wish. Troy Rutter is working with Kim Johnson, our PC Campus Recruiter, the Chicago PC office, and a small team of members come up with a program. Ideas so far are presentations throughout the day on PC experiences, a special presentation for high school students, a Global House Party selling Peace and Harmony tea from Serendipitea (www.serendipitea.com), and more. 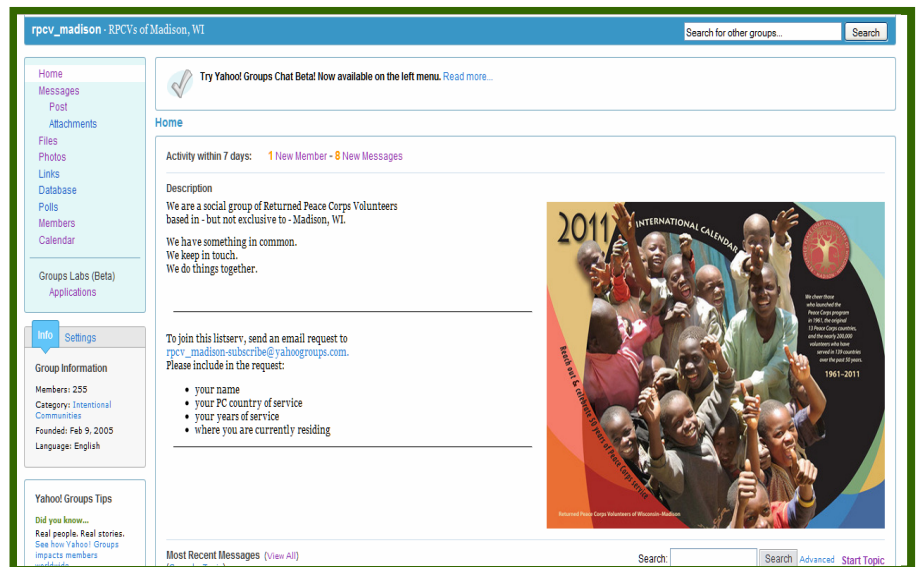
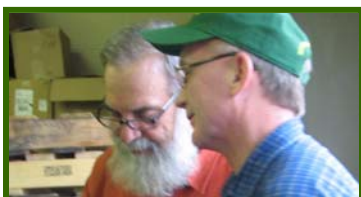
Speaking of Listservs...

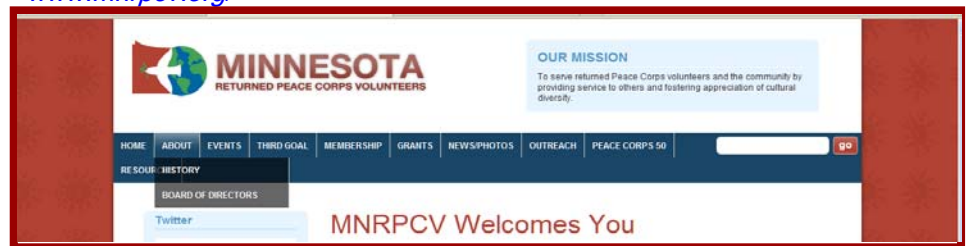
A screen shot of our listserv page
